

On October 8th we had the pleasure of hosting an open house to show the community our recent renovations and newest service. In addition to our emergency youth housing, we will now be able to have long term housing for homeless youth ages 16 to 21. The new expansion was a dream of the staff and the board. Through hard work and a coordinated community effort, we were able to bring this dream to life. We held a design contest in the spring for local high school students to design the "perfect bedroom" for a homeless kid.

The winning designs were used by community and business partners to paint, furnish and decorate the rooms. Each room has its own unique feel and style to make the youth feel like they have a true home. There is also a large kitchen with many tables to work and socialize, and two living rooms with plenty of games and movies.

The day was filled with joy of all kinds. We were able to give some of the student designers tours and they were so amazed to see their designs in person. We were able to give tours to our local State Police, Mayor Moran, and State Senator Judy Schwank who are excited at what we will be able to do. We were also pleased to have so

many visitors from all over the community come to celebrate with us.

I am a new board member for Mary's Shelter and due to the pandemic, this was the first event that I was able to attend. After all of the recent struggles it was so heartwarming and uplifting to see just how appreciated we are by the community and how willing so many people are to come together to make a project like this work.

Even though most of the hard physical work is now completed, once we are able to open the housing for homeless youth the real work will begin. There are going to be new continual needs for these young adults which will be different than our maternity clients. We are confident in our neighbors to help meet these needs and get our clients the help they need and the start in life that will make them successful adults.
